- Hair cutting and styling
- Hair coloring
- Permanent waving
- Manicuring
- Facials and facial make-up
- Diseases of skin and scalp

COSMETOLOGY

Learn the science of beautifying and improving the complexion, skin, hair, and nails in the Cosmetology Program offered through the Tuscola Technology Center at Bayshire Beauty Academy in Caro. This course of study is 1,500 hours. Students will have 350 hours of classroom and laboratory study followed by 1,150 hours of practical experience with the guidance of professional instructors.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

- Apron/smock and shoes will be required
- Total training time required by the State of Michigan is 1,500 hours—attendance is strictly monitored by a time card
- Much of your time is spent on your feet
- You must be 16 years of age
- You must have a ninth grade education or it's equivalent

WHERE YOU CAN GO FROM HERE:

Following 1,500 hours and completion of this program, you will be qualified to take the State Board Exam to become a Licensed Cosmetologist. You may also specialize in a particular area of Cosmetology.

Upon completion and State Licensure, student will earn 20 college credits toward Cosmetology Management Associate's Degree at Delta College.
